

Taking a Picture of Your Screen on a Mac

Make sure the window or application in which the figure or picture resides is active.


Type Command-Shift-4. A “rifle-sight” icon will appear.


Click-hold-and-drag over the area you wish to copy. Then release.
You will hear a “camera shutter” sound.

A PNG image will appear on your Desktop.
It’s filename will be “Screen Shot” with the date and time at which it was created.
See below for examples.

If you want a picture of the entire screen, Type Command-Shift-3.
You will hear a “camera shutter” sound.
Again, a PNG image will appear on your Desktop with the same naming scheme.

Also try Command-Shift-5 and see what happens!
