Value of Ivy MS-IS Degree

- ❖ Our MS-IS program is the only one offered in Iowa
- **❖** Easily completed in three semesters
- ❖ 100% Employment within 3 months after graduation.
- Highest paid of all the Ivy Master programs.
 - Average <u>starting</u> salary for MS-IS students from the Ivy College was \$78,333
 - Average <u>starting</u> salary in the USA for Bachelor students is \$55,000
- **❖ STEM designation** is beneficial for international students

Master of Science in Information Systems – Questions...

Why would I do a Master of Science in Information Systems (MS-IS)?

- ❖ There is <u>no</u> industry where applying technology to solve business problems is <u>not a priority</u>
- ❖ All employers need trained professionals who can apply cutting-edge technology to solve real-world business problems.
- Significantly <u>increases</u> your earnings power over your <u>lifetime career</u>
- ❖ Prepares you for leadership careers in IT and business

Master of Science in Information Systems – Questions...

Where can I work with an MS-IS degree?

- ❖ Job are found around the globe.
- ❖ Embark on business careers in management of computers and information technology such as:
 - Running IT projects
 - Looking after network security
 - Setting goals and developing plans for implementing computer systems for organizations.
- ❖ Typical positions are
 - Systems architect
 - Strategic technology consultant
 - Programming leader
 - Product manager

Master of Science in Information Systems – Questions...

How long does it take to complete?

- You need to complete 30 credits
- Majority of students complete the program in 3 semesters. Some complete the program in 2 semesters

How much does it cost?

- Fall 2020 Resident Cost (Tuition and Fees inclusive) is \$6,883 per semester. 3-semester cost = \$20,649
- Fall 2020 Nonresident Cost (Tuition and Fees inclusive) is \$14,582 per semester. 3-semester cost = \$43,746
- Fall 2020 International Cost (Tuition and Fees inclusive) is \$15,398 per semester. 3-semester cost = \$46,194

How can I pay for my MS-IS?

- A limited number Graduate Assistantships for qualified students
- Four Heartland Scholarships of \$5,000/year, one-time only (for lowa Residents)
- To be considered for graduate assistantships, check box on application
- All qualified students are automatically considered for Heartland scholarships. No additional application is needed

When can I start?

- Immediately after graduating with your bachelor's degree
- Can start program in Fall or Spring. No Summer starts.

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS

- Two Graduate Assistantships are available for qualified students
- To be considered for graduate assistantships, no separate application is needed. Just check box in your application requesting to be considered for a graduate assistantship



- Work for 10 hours/week




GMAC 2019 Survey by Program – Master's vs. Bachelor's



Starting Salary Makes a Big Difference

- Every time you change jobs or get promoted you will be asked, "What is your current salary?"
- ❖ Your new salary will be a percentage increase (say 5% to 10%) of your current salary.
- ❖ With a higher starting salary, your raise in total dollars will always be greater than with a lower starting salary.
- Example:
 - 10% of \$55,000 is **\$5,500** → New Salary is **\$60,500**
 - 10% of \$78,000 is **\$7,800** → New Salary is **\$85,800** a big difference!
- ❖ In 30 years, earning \$23,000 more per year, you earn \$690,000 more, than with a bachelor's degree.
- That is significant earnings power for most people.

Effect of Starting Salary over 30 year Career*



* Example only. Shows the effect of compounding on starting salary. Not a guaranteed result. Career earnings depend on many unpredictable factors

In many cases, true Payback is much shorter

Payback <u>excludes the life-long increased earnings</u> beyond the payback period which is the main reason for doing the Master of Science in Information Systems

What are the Application Requirements?

- 1) Online application
- 2) Resume
- 3) Essays
- 4) Statement of Purpose.
 - One page maximum. Address your qualifications, work experience, and career aspirations.
- 5) Contact information for two references.
- 6) Transcripts from all completed degrees
 - ❖ Waived for Iowa State University degree
- 7) Test scores GMAT or GRE.

- GMAT/GRE may be waived for applicants with outstanding backgrounds reflected in multiple ways, such as:
 - ✓ Good work experience
 - ✓ Valued industry certificates
 - ✓ Good undergraduate GPA, etc.
- All waivers require approval by Prof. Ray Chen - <u>ruichen@iastate.edu</u>
- May be waived for Ivy College majors with a GPA of 3.25 or better
- GMAT/GRE required for all other applicants.
- TOEFL or IELTS test scores are required for international applicants educated outside of the United States.

For Fall admission apply by July 1
For Spring admission apply by December 1
